Attendees are required to wear face masks at masses. Additional instructions about new church protocols in response to COVID-19 will be provided before Mass begins – seating guidelines, social distancing, interior walking routes, directions for the reception of Holy Communion, etc. If you don't feel well, if you are uncomfortable about attending Mass at this time, you have been granted a dispensation.
