After receiving an update from Maryland State officials on the current impact of the COVID-19 virus and acting on the advice of medical professionals, Archbishop William E. Lori has determined that to safeguard the well-being of the faithful of the Archdiocese of Baltimore and to prevent further community spread of the virus, all public Masses are canceled until further notice. We anticipate the resumption of our Community Mass celebrations in the next few weeks.

The Masses will re-air on WCMB AM-680 at 7 p.m. every Sunday.

In compliance to Government Guidelines, in the Archdiocese of Baltimore:

- (1) MASSES are to be offered <u>without the physical</u> presence of the faithful until further notice.
- **(2)** MASSES *may not be celebrated* for small groups of the faithful in chapels or homes.
- (3) CHURCH OFFICES are <u>not considered "essential businesses"</u> and for that reason must be closed to the public and remain closed until this restriction is lifted by the State of Maryland. ACCORDINGLY, <u>NAS CHURCH OFFICE IS CLOSED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.</u>
