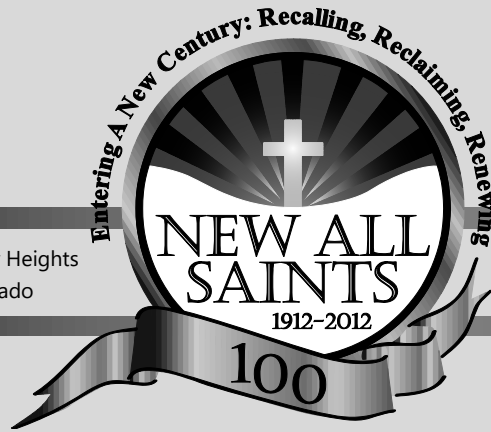

COMMUNITY CELEBRATION OF MASS ANNOUNCEMENT from the Archdiocese of Baltimore

Effective now, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass in person during the COVID-19 health crisis has been lifted, a major milestone in our journey back to normalcy. In light of this important transition, **the Archdiocese has removed all Covid-19 social distancing restrictions, where jurisdictions allow.** *The lifting of general dispensation and removing restrictions went into effect on June 26 and 27.*
