## NEW ALL SAINTS CHURCH BULLETIN "FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME" JULY 16, 2023

IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF BALTIMORE ALL ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND MASS! On March 1, 2022, the indoor mask mandate for Baltimore City was lifted. Parishes within the city no longer must require masking in church buildings or during Mass. Unless a parish's local authority has a mask mandate in place, parishioners are <u>not required</u> to mask to attend Mass. If local conditions worsen, such as high case rates and high transmissibility, we may suggest wearing a mask, but in the absence of a governmental mandate, masking is not mandated for attending Mass.
