Reflections from Fr. Uju: Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

The story of the incarnation opened to us the mystery of God's Son coming to be with us. This Son of God while doing His ministry spoke of Himself as one sent by the Father (Jn. 6, 44; 6, 57). That concept made us begin to see a distinction between Jesus and God the Father. Further in the ministry He equally spoke of the unique identity He enjoys with the Father – one that is undistinguishable—when He said, “the Father and I are one” (Jn. 10, 30). As we ruminate on this, Jesus before He ascended, spoke of the Holy Spirit as not only integrally united with God (Jn. 15, 26) but also as a form of God's abiding presence with the believers. Therein, we saw also a form of a separate identity—like saying “Baptize them, in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. However way we look at this Solemnity and doctrine of the Holy Trinity, it is simply the mystery of the God of life who does all in and for love. God spoke things into being and this brought life to be. When this life lost its purity and fell out of grace, God sent the Son to save it and to bring about a restoration of life. Later, before the Son ascended into Heaven, He promised the followers the Holy Spirit who comes to reinvigorate them for the task of bringing about the renewal of life in people wherever they may be. On a special note, this mystery of love and life is one which should define every Christian because we are all baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Even when we were little and started to learn how to pray it always began with the invocation of the Holy Trinity. This means that the life of a Christian should reflect the life and love of God. But the great question today for many of us is do our lives bear witness that we are heirs of the Divine who must live and act in ways that respect the life and love of God in all peoples? May the Blessed Trinity be with us now and forever.
