28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Scripture reading today individually points to one thing which stands out above all others. In the first reading it is called wisdom. The letter to the Hebrews sees it as the word of God; and in the Gospel reading it was trust in divine providence. These things which the readings point to individually are such that the recipients find nothing of equal value and so they are ready to risk every other thing for them. It is like saying that this surpasses all others because this one thing gives me all that the other things hold combined. It is easy to see why wisdom can give one more because it is a gift that helps one to choose rightly and we know that blessings come from wise choices. On the other hand, we can accept, as people of faith, the pre-eminent place of the word of God which can give us all things if we listen to it and follow its direction. However, the scenario of the Gospel is a little more difficult because one can easily ask: how does poverty offer me all other things? But reading further you find that it is not in selling everything that the blessings come but in doing so and giving the proceeds to the poor and following Jesus. This is what we call trust in divine providence. Trusting in God offers one everything because we cannot out-do **God** in generosity (2Cor. 9:6-10). The problem of our world is that we **Trust in the power of people and material things**. The Bible makes us understand they will not last, and they may even fail us. The Bible also tells us that those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion that cannot be shaken and that stands firm forever (Ps. 125). Therefore, the choice for you and me this week is to re-examine our life pursuits and ask which of them is the key to every other thing; and which of them endures for years to come. The wisdom of God, the word of God, and our trust in it (them) holds the key. Take it and use it; and surely it can heal all the pains that we have felt these past days, even from the challenges posed by the word of God broken for us. Remain blessed. **Fr. Uju**
