WEEKLY REFLECTION

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

On this **Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**, we are invited to reflect deeply on the beauty and power of God's Word, as today is observed as "**Sunday of the Word of God.**" It is a day to celebrate, study, and share the Scriptures—the living Word that guides and sustains us in our journey of faith.

In today's Gospel (Matthew 4:12-23), we hear how Jesus calls His first disciples.
