## WEEKLY REFLECTION

Beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

**G**race and peace be with you. This week, we reflect on Luke 5:1-11, a passage that speaks to the transformative power of Christ's call in our lives. In this gospel, we witness Simon Peter, weary from a fruitless night of fishing, reluctantly obeying Jesus' command to cast his net into the deep. To his astonishment, he hauls in a miraculous catch, so abundant that the nets begin to break. Overwhelmed, Peter falls at Jesus' feet, feeling unworthy of His presence. Yet, Jesus responds with a call, not condemnation: "Do not be afraid; from now on, you will be catching men."

**T**his passage challenges us to trust in the Lord, even when we feel discouraged or exhausted by our own efforts. Like Peter, we may have experienced failures, doubts, or feelings of inadequacy. But Jesus calls us to deeper faith, reminding us that His power is greater than our limitations. When we allow Christ to direct our efforts, we find blessings beyond our imagination.

**T**his gospel also speaks to our mission as a faith community. We are called to be "fishers of people," to share the love of Christ with those who feel lost, forgotten, or overwhelmed by life's struggles. Evangelization is not reserved for the few—it is the work of all believers. Through acts of kindness, words of encouragement, and a life rooted in faith, we cast our own nets into the world, bringing others closer to God.
