WEEKLY REFLECTION

Dear Beloved Parishioners,

This week's Gospel from Luke 6:17, 20-26 presents us with Jesus' profound teaching on the Beatitudes, where He proclaims blessings upon the poor, the hungry, and those who suffer for righteousness. At the same time, He warns those who are rich, satisfied, and well-regarded in this world. These words may seem challenging, yet they reveal the heart of God's Kingdom—a place where true blessings are not found in material wealth or human approval but in a life deeply rooted in faith and dependence on God.

Jesus calls us to a radical way of living, one that is countercultural. Society tells us to seek comfort, status, and personal gain, but Christ reminds us that the real treasure lies in our relationship with God and in our care for one another, especially the most vulnerable. When we endure struggles, we are not abandoned; rather, we are drawn closer to God's grace.

As we reflect on this passage, let us ask ourselves: Where do we place our trust? Do we find our security in worldly things, or do we rely on God's promises? Let us strive to be people of faith, who serve with humility, love with sincerity, and trust in God's eternal rewards. May the blessings of Christ fill your hearts and homes this week.
