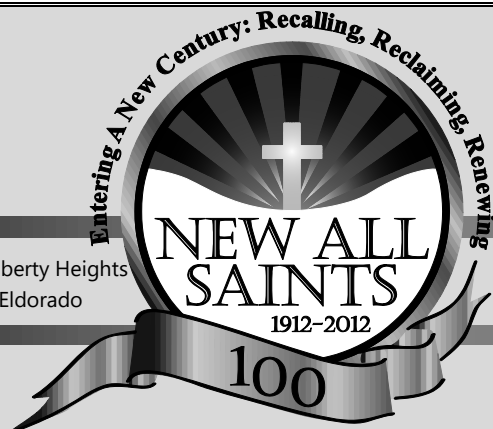

IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF BALTIMORE ALL ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND MASS! On March 1, 2022, the indoor mask mandate for Baltimore City was lifted. Parishes within the city no longer must require masking in church buildings or during Mass. Unless a parish's local jurisdiction has a mask mandate in place, parishioners are not required to mask to attend Mass. If local conditions worsen, such as high case rates and high transmissibility, we may suggest wearing a mask, but in the absence of a governmental mandate, masking is not mandated for attending Mass.

- ❖ **PLANNING TO MARRY?** Arrangements should be made by the Parish Office at least six months in advance.

 - ❖ **ILL, HOME-BOUND, IN THE HOSPITAL, UNABLE TO ATTEND MASS?** Please notify the Church office so that contact can be made for visits and reception of the sacraments.
 - ❖ **MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:** Entering the hospital for a medical procedure? "Anointing of the Sick" may be administered prior to medical procedures and at medical center. Contact the Parish office or see clergy.
